Dear ACLS Experienced Provider Student,

Thank you for choosing the ACLS for Experienced Provider Renewal course as a way to renew your ACLS. This Renewal class is designed for the student who has taken an ACLS Renewal Course at LEAST twice. The material is not designed for the beginner ACLS student. This class focuses on the causes of arrest and interventions to prevent arrest.

Please see the agenda on the Education website for class details. We have been asked to park at the far ends of the parking lot of the 7836 building so that patients visiting physicians in the 7836 building may park close to the entrance.

Because the ACLS EP is a renewal course, the student is expected to come prepared and be able to demonstrate basic BLS and ACLS. To pass an ACLS renewal course you will need to;

- Pass the written exam with a score of 84% or better
- Be the code team lead during the Mega Code
- Complete one rescuer CPR with AED

A pretest and study material is available at www.heart.org/eccstudent. The code word is 'compression'
